



COACHES' CODE OF CONDUCT 2008 - MIGB BOOSTER CLUB

Coaches are required to adhere to the following code of conduct:

- Encourage players to reach their full potential as strong young women and as basketball players. Promote healthy balance and support players in prioritizing personal, family and scholastic obligations before basketball.
- Reinforce strong effort and self-improvement with positive encouragement.
- Do your best to ensure that all players receive equal coaching time at practices.
- Model good sportsmanship in how you address opponents, referees, players and parents and demand the same positive behaviors from all players.
- Model good problem solving skills in addressing competitive challenges and disappointments and teach your players the mental skills needed to be competitive.
- Engage in open and constructive communication and encourage players to address you directly with concerns about their contribution to the team, playing time, or other issues that arise.
- Demand zero tolerance for discrimination, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco and immediately report any concerns in this regard to the Club Board.
