



PARENT / GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT 2008 - MIGB BOOSTER CLUB

Parents / Guardians are required to adhere to the following code of conduct:

- Do not criticize referees (allow the coaches to decide what to say and when)
- Do not coach from the stands (parents often do not know the coaching goal or plan - allow the players to hear the coach and only the coach).
- Do not criticize your daughter in the car after the game (studies show this is the worst memory student athletes have of playing sports).
- Do not compare your daughter to her teammates - use good judgment in how you discuss other players in front of your daughter and others.
- Wait until after a game to approach coaches with issues or concerns.
- Support your coaches in teaching players to be cooperative team members.
- Encourage your daughter to address her concerns directly with her coach and comply with the established grievance procedures.
- Cheer for your daughter's team, not against the opposing team in a negative manner.
- Do not use foul language.
